For every word in Scripture there is a balanced word, i.e. faith and works, heaven and hell, angels and demons, etc. 4. My Word is perfectly balanced. 5. Do not teach anything before you have the balance to that subject. 6. Record the entire Scripture passages and references on each subject. 7. Print out My Word directly from the Bible passages. 8. The best commentary on the Bible is the Bible. 9. Do not make this a commentary of your teachings but rather of My Word. 10. The Holy Spirit is the primary Teacher. 11. Only use Hebrew and Greek definitions of words to clarify word meanings. 12. The Bible does not contradict itself, so keep reading until the answer is found. 13. My Word is the "plumb-line" of Truth. 14. On either side of the "plumb-line" of Truth there are two

ditches: Legalism and License. 15. The Truth sets you free and you are free indeed. What began as one teaching has developed into hundreds of teachings. It is to these principles and directives that I have adhered and have recorded the teachings He has revealed to me over the past 40 years.
